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**The Third Mobility / Project Meeting, Katerini-Greece -Platon M.E.P.E,**  
**10-11 October 2018**

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A team from the "Gheorghe Țițeica" Secondary School Craiova (consisting of two adults and two students) participated in the third mobility / project meeting Erasmus+, KA 2- Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices, KA 201- Strategic Partnerships for school education: Early Innovation Capacity - **iCAP** (Fostering innovation interest and building innovation capacity among secondary school students through opening up new learning spaces for young learners), *Agreement no 2017-1-UK01-KA201-036517* organised at **Katerini – Platon M.E.P.E.**

The project is implemented over a period of 2 years (01.09.2017-31.08.2019) in 5 countries - UK-England, Greece, Romania, Slovenia and Spain- by the applicant:University of Gloucestershire, Cheltenham, UK. The partners of this project are :University of Thessaly-Greece, Platon M.E.P.E., Katerini- Greece, Școala Gimnazială Gheorghe Titeica Craiova-Romania, Solski Centre Kranj, Kranj-Slovenia, Furness Academies Trust, Barrow-in-Furness-UK, Institut de Vilafant, Vilafant-Spain, Working with Europe-Spain.



"Because student teams are at the heart of the project, all resources are geared towards facilitating their involvement as co-creators and innovators throughout the implementation period. We are in the third stage of the project, the "Let's Innovate" phase where, in addition to engaging in the local community's own challenges, each team of the 5 partner countries provides useful reflections and contributions, including parallel challenges, similar and possible solutions both for partners and for their own community. This stage is very dynamic and produces considerable documentation that will contribute to the development of results. "In each of the communities, community collaborators create real-time challenges for each team of students". - said teacher Cerasela Cremene, manager of "Gheorghe Țițeica" Secondary School in Craiova.



During the meeting, the actions that each partner has carried out since the last meeting were discussed and analyzed. Thus, the agenda of the first day included debates - in group and separately: teachers - on the subject of increasing interest in innovation in secondary schools (illustrated study and good practice guide), video presentations entitled "I am an Innovator", recommendations on future iCAP meetings. There were also completed the documents necessary for the smooth running of the project. The second day of the meeting included free discussions between teachers and pupils - separately and in groups, examples of good practice and setting out details for future actions and meetings. Also, each crew presented some of the specific activities undertaken within the project over the last 6 months, including: The courtyard garden in Slovenia, Theatrical play-Romania, Bicycle track-Greece, The fight against cancer-Spain, etc.
